Someone in my family is symptomatic with Covid-19 but I am well.	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	3	6	Archer MUST refrain from coming to the Archery Range and Facilities for at least 14 Days.	1
Cross Contamination between Archers	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	3	6	Archers MUST maintain a minimum 2m distance at all times. Maximum archers on a target of 10 to facilitate this, booked in advance. Field access secured to avoid additional people entering the field area. Each archer's shooting position should be marked out on the shooting line accordingly (for example using footmarkers or a spare arrow). Archers must only collect their own arrows; if scoring, circles should be marked on the ground, rather than the use of scoring ropes, to facilitate this.	1

Cross Contamination from Toilet Facilities	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	3	6	Toilet Facilities are out of bounds, though likely to be unavailable as within the Leisure Centre (currently closed). Toilet Facilities may be used in emergencies only. However, the person using the toilet MUST disinfect the facility, their hands and their equipment after use.	1
Cross contamination from Flags, Line Ropes and Scoring Ropes	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	1	4	All equipment required for field layout MUST be provided, set out, and collected in by that person. Only that person should come into contact with field equipment at any time. There are multiple sets of field equipment allocated to several members. <i>*unless from the same household</i>	1
Cross contamination from Shooting Equipment	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	1	4	All equipment required for shooting (bow, arrows, stand, quiver, arm-guard, tab, etc) MUST be brought by the individual archer and not shared. Archers only handle their own equipment. Hand sanitiser should be provided by individuals, to use as required. <i>*unless from the same household</i>	1
Becoming ill whilst on the Archery Range.	Infection may be passed to another Archer and their families etc	All	3	3	6	Should you become ill whilst you are at the Archery Range, you MUST inform someone, immediately leave the Range and go home. Please arrange urgent support should you find yourself seriously sick whilst you are at the range.	1



Designation	Classification	Action
5 to 6	Unacceptable	This situation is not tolerable. Shooting shall not start or be continued until the risk has been reduced.
4	Tolerable	Shooting can continue as long as all control measures are in place and observed
2 to 3	Low	Little or no risk
