THE SIEGE OF HARFLEUR

Saturday 1st August 2026 at 11am Registration from 9am

Entry fee £15 (seniors and juniors) to include a mid-siege feast (fish&chips), and entry into the Final Advancing Volley

Archers will be organised as follows...

Longbow Traditional (wooden, non-longbow) Barebow

Sighting aids of any kind are not permitted

Harfleur Castle will be besieged from the following distances;

Seniors 4 dozen each at 100, and 80 yards

Juniors (U16) 4 dozen each at 80, and 60 yards

The final end at each distance will be shot in volleys

A **Final Advancing Volley** will be shot approaching the Keep, the best headshot claiming the **Lady's Purse of £50**

Rations (refreshments) available all day

Medieval dress is encouraged!

ENTRY

- Deadline for entry is Friday 24th July or when full. Due to food ordering, refunds on entry fees cannot be made after the deadline
- Juniors count as U16, however juniors or seniors can shoot the closer/further distances if preferred, to
 add challenge or give a chance of hitting (we want you to have some sense of achievement!). However
 for seniors shooting the junior distance, scores will not count when allocating awards

TARGETS

- We will be shooting at life-sized targets of castle walls and soldiers, made from a layered sandwich of
 extruded polystyrene insulation boards, carpet, and thin plywood (just like the castles of old...)
- Although the targets haven't yet made it into the rule book, ArcheryGB rules of shooting relating to safety and technique are applied. Scoring is a little more vague, and in all reality, optional

EQUIPMENT

- In keeping with the nature of this tournament (ie not damaging the targets), there are three categories of bow types allowed; Longbow, Traditional (ie any all-wood bow that is not a longbow), and Barebow (ie modern recurve without the cheating dangly bits)
- No sighting aids of any kind are allowed (eyes are permissible so long as you squint)

DRESS

Whilst it is not a requirement, you are encouraged to enter into the 'spirit of the thing' by dressing up appropriately for medieval battle. Note: there is no documented evidence of zombies, Elvis, or naughty nurses* in 15th Century battle (*note to self; don't research this at work)

FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS

- Refreshments (drinks and snacks) will be available to purchase throughout the day
- Halfway through the shoot we will break for feasting please make sure you enter your choice of meal
 on the entry form. Meal choices cannot be changed after the deadline, due to pre-ordering
- Additional meals for non-shooting guests can be ordered at a cost of £8 each. Please enter online and select 'non-shooting'

HENRY V's LAWS

- Private insurance for this event allows entry from archers affiliated to all national archery organisations and/or private archery clubs - basic safety rules for archery must be understood and followed; the event will be run under ArcheryGB rules
- Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify consent to their child taking part
- In view of the provisions of the ArcheryGB protection of children and vulnerable adults policy, persons
 wishing not to be photographed should advise the organiser at the time of entering
