(no Compound, or fully carbon arrows)

Ladies - 100yds Gents - 140yds

Juniors (U18) - 80yds

- Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian
- Those wishing to use photographic/video equipment at this event are to register upon arrival. Persons wishing not to be photographed should advise the organisers at the time of entering the competition

TCC Winter Wand Rules

1. Bow Styles

- Longbows – wooden arrows
- Barebows – aluminum/composite arrows (NO all carbon arrows allowed)
- Recurves – aluminum/composite arrows (NO all carbon arrows allowed)

ALL ARROWS MUST BE ACCOUNTED FOR AT THE END OF THE SHOOT

Note: Flatbows & Traditional bows will be classed as Barebow; Compounds/Crossbows are not permitted

2. Targets

All wands are 6' tall, made up of solid timber backing covered in 2" thick closed cell foam, covered in 2" Etha foam, supported by 3 guy ropes with small coloured indicator flags on top

- Juniors (under 18) – 6" wand @ 80yds
- Ladies – 6" wand @ 100yds
- Gents – 6" wand @ 140yds

All wands will have a 5' scoring circle marked on the ground Juniors may shoot up a distance but will be included within the senior scores for awards

3. Round

The wand shoot is a double round consisting of a single round of 3 doz arrows + 6 sighters (before the first round only), a lunch break then a second single round of 3 doz arrows (no sighters)

4. Shooting

Untimed ends in 2 details, with arrows being shot in sets of 6

5. Scoring

- Arrow imbedded in the wand 1 point
- Arrow within scoring circle 1 point

Results will be determined by Wands, then Circles (if all are equal then the round will be called a draw)

6. Awards

Junior Boys/Girls will compete against each other
Returnable Trophies for 1st place + medals

- Juniors 6" wand 80yds Longbow, Barebow, Recurve
- Ladies 6" wand 100yds Longbow, Barebow, Recurve
- Gents 6" wand 140yds Longbow, Barebow, Recurve
